Aim: To identify sightings or signs of named mammals.

1. What is a Mammal ? Have some pictures handy.
Write a definition of a Mammal.

2. The 6 Survey mammals are: **Badger**
 Red Fox
 Grey Squirrel
 Rabbit
 Hedgehog
 Mole

Draw accurate pictures of three of them and colour them correctly.

3. What is a Habitat ? Write a definition of a Habitat.

4. What type of Habitat will your three mammals live in? Write a short description of the three habitats.

5. Wild creatures are not easy to see but they leave signs of their presence. For each mammal in the list write or draw one sign they may leave. Discuss what other people think. Draw up a list of **Signs** to look for. (droppings, footprints, chewed nuts/ cones, fur on wire or fence, holes, molehills, scrapings)

6. Explore your School Grounds for signs of animal activity. Record everything you find.

7. Look in your garden at home for signs as well. Record everything you see.

8. Put your School Post Code and Home Post Code on your survey forms.
