1. What is the difference between a **Reptile** and an **Amphibian** ?
Write a definition for each of them and draw a picture of an example of each.
2. Which of these is an Amphibian and which is a Reptile?
a) Common Frog b) Grass Snake
c) Common Toad d) Slow-Worm
3. Describe the difference between a Common Frog and Common Toad.
Draw pictures to show this.
4. Describe the difference between a Grass Snake and a Slow-Worm.
Draw pictures to show this.
5. Frogs and Toads lay **Spawn** in ponds. This is their eggs.
How can you tell which is which ? Illustrate this.
If you find Spawn it means frogs / toads are present.
6. Where would you be most likely to find grass snakes and slow-worms ?
Are there any signs they may leave to tell you where they are ?
7. Survey either your school grounds or your garden for signs of these four creatures. Record everything you find on your survey form.
