

### KS 3 Wildlife Survey of School Grounds and Home Gardens.

#### Aim : To Record Sightings of Specific Birds, Mammals, Reptiles and Amphibians.

1. Write a **Definition** for each of these groups : **Birds**  
**Mammals**  
**Reptiles**  
**Amphibians.**

Put each of these into one of the above groups:  
Common Toad, Badger, Mole, Robin, Slow-Worm, Hedgehog, Grass Snake

2. Use references to ensure you can identify the following:  
**Grass Snake and Slow-Worm**  
**Common Frog and Common Toad**  
You can illustrate these if you wish.
3. Only three **Birds** are in the survey ... **Robin, Blackbird and Blue Tit.**  
Make sure you can identify them easily.

4. It is not always possible to see creatures in the wild but they do leave signs of their presence.  
Write down as many signs as possible that these creatures could leave:

**Mammals** Badger, Red Fox, Hedgehog, Rabbit, Mole, Grey Squirrel.  
**Reptiles / Amphibians** Common Frog, Common Toad, Grass Snake, Slow-Worm.
