

Unit 2B Plants and Animals in the Local Environment.

Year 2.

1. Looking for Plants and Animals.

Activities: Walk around the school grounds or visit a local park to identify where plants are growing and where there are animals.

- Remember trees are plants.
- Carefully look under stones / logs; under bushes; dig in the soil.

Have a prepared plan for children to record their initial findings as they go along.

Outcomes: Identify plants and animals found. Draw them and label them.

State WHERE each were found.

eg: Daisies in grass. Caterpillar on Ragwort.

Draw a plan showing where each were found. Can you name the different types of HABITAT. eg: Hedge. Playground, Garden

Objectives:

- That there are different kinds of plants and animals in the immediate environment
- Treat animals and the environment with care and sensitivity
- Observe and make a record of animals and plants found
- To present results in a table
