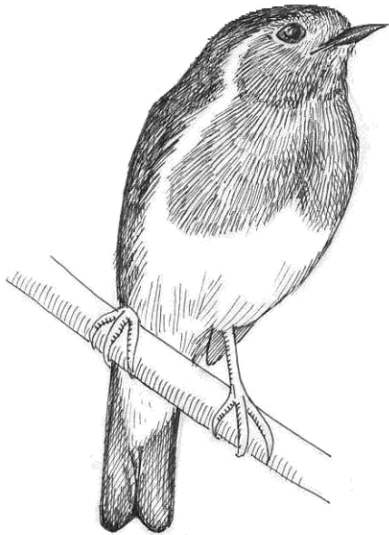
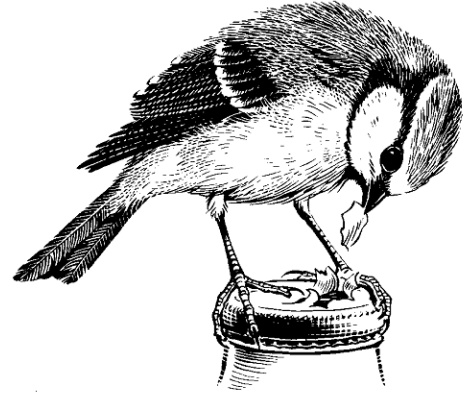

Blue Tit (*Parus caeruleus*)

- Small bird with pale blue head, pale blue wings, and bright yellow chest;
- Has a white face with a black stripe going from its beak to its eye to the back of its head;
- Can be seen feeding high trees or on garden feeders.



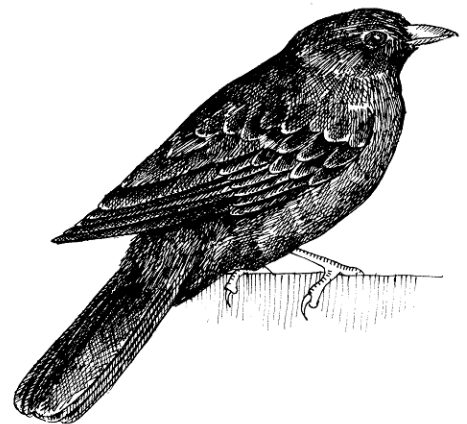
Robin (*Erithacus rubecula*)*

- Both male and female have bright red faces and chests and brown back;
- Robins usually feed on the ground and can be seen bobbing along;
- Can be seen and heard in trees singing loudly to advertise their territory.

When	Where

Blackbird (*Turdus merula*)*

- Adult males have black feathers and a bright yellow bill;
- Adult females have brown feathers, and a brown beak, but the older females have orange beaks;
- First year males have more brown in plumage and brownish bill;
- Blackbirds feed on the ground and often run and hop along the floor.
